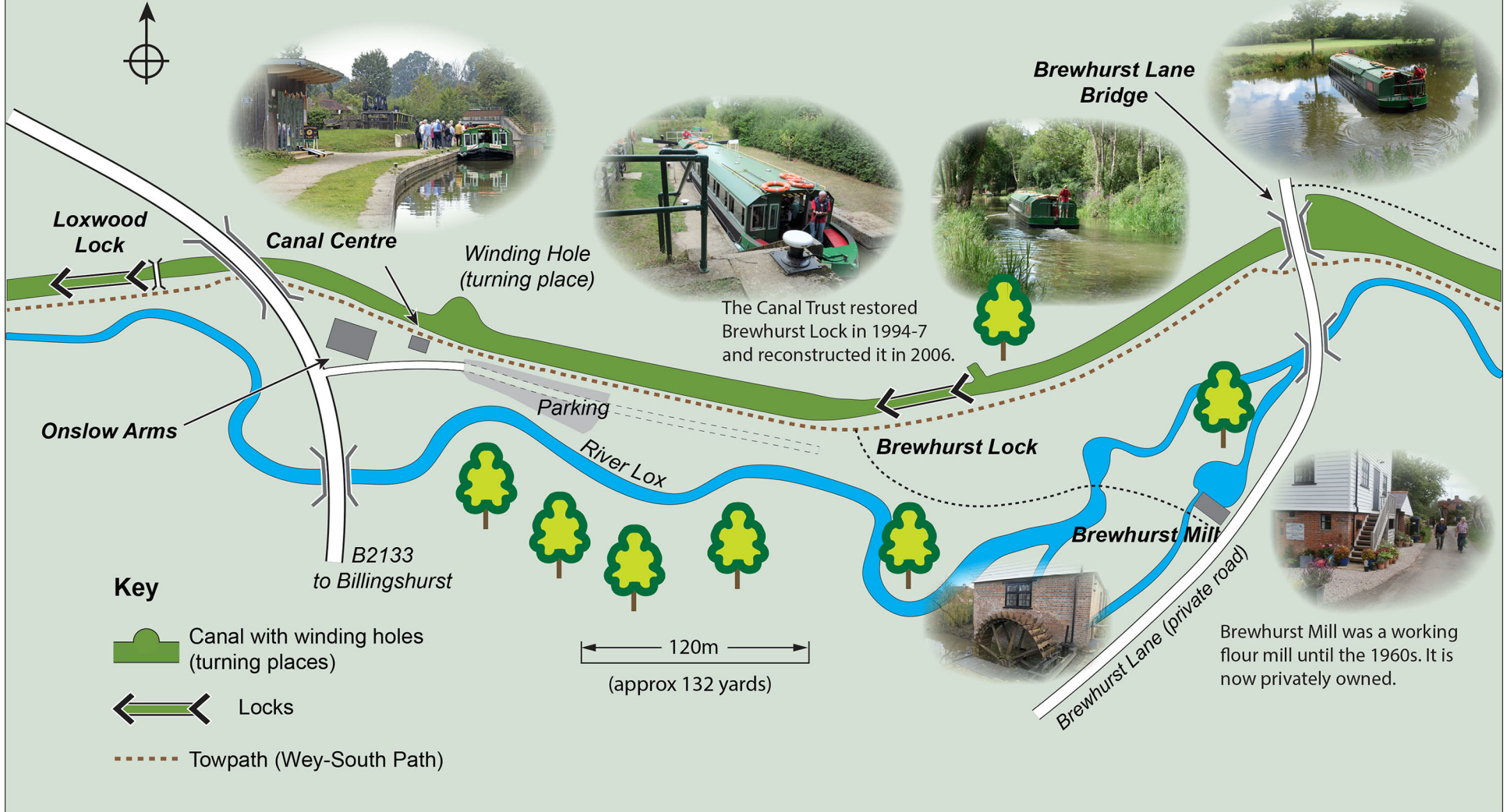





Boat Trips
