

Rooks Hill Project Oct update





Background

- 900 metres of canal and footpath at Birtley restored 2018 - 2023
- Two new lifting bridges installed
- Circular footpath route with Downslink established and well used
- Water supply from springs at the northern end

Rooks Hill

- One of the Trust's priority areas
- Extends useable canal south from Birtley
- Includes first new length of canal since WACT formed
- Phased project Phase 1 underway



Three phases

Phase 1:

- Bridleway brick faced concrete overbridge and approach ramps
- 100m of waterway bank retaining wall
- Overflow weir
- Repair Fanesbridge culvert

Phase 1 Timetable

June Dig out bridge hole and cast base

July WRG summer camps

Bridge abutments, Culvert









Summer Camps

- D of E volunteers gold award



































The waterway bank retaining wall and overflow weir















The Culvert














Phase 2 - 2026/2027

- 300 metres of newly dug canal north from bridge
- Soft banks with coir rolls planted to enhance ecology
- Narrows section to link to existing canal
- New hedge and tree planting
- 3 metre wide permissive footpath from Birtley to the Greensand Way
- West bank Bridge to Fanesbridge boundary






Phase 2 Current status

- Planning permission issued Feb 2025
- Major excavation material disposal?
- Plastic wood donated by John Lewis
- Coir rolls and gabions needed
- Funding required
- Start summer 2026?

Phase 3 - 2027 +

- Fanesbridge Lock planning permission granted
- Tree work 2025/6
- part of Rushetts scheme?
